



## PARENTAL/GUARDIAN INVOLVEMENT

- Be sure to encourage their student to attend school regularly in accordance with legislation
- Encourage student participation in the wide variety of activities SEC has made available both in the school and in the lodge
- Show appreciation and support for the school and lodges' efforts in providing care for your student
- Instill in their student the desire to work to the best of his/her ability
- Remind students to have respect for property and resources while at SEC
- Ensure their Student respect the rights of fellow students and staff
- Contact the Director/Principal when there are areas of concern or if you require additional support
- Must be collectively responsible for their students' education

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
