Currently teachers are required to incorporate as per the (TRC) Truth and Reconciliation Commission 94 Calls to Action. Indigenous Cultural perspectives will be implemented across the entire SEC curriculums.

Aboriginal Culture and Heritage along with sustainable development curriculums are currently being addressed with partnership with The Manitoba Museum. Curriculum is being developed with the assistance of SEC students to collaborate on the development of activities that will address the pristine forest in our Southeast Region of Manitoba.

In addition SEC has now included Land Based Education initiatives that provide across curricular activities for SEC students to enhance their learning environment. In addition this creates long lasting partnerships/relationships with Turtle Island, Black River First Nation and local environmentalist and wellness keepers of knowledge.
