



Withdrawal/Expulsion

Student Withdrawal

SEC Board is committed to a safe learning and working environment for all students and staff. In order to maintain such an environment, withdrawal of students is sometimes necessary. Withdrawal of a student is considered a necessary course of action and is in response to student behaviour that is severe, dangerous or which may poses a risk or threat to the student or to other student(s) and/or staff.

A withdrawal may also result from the students' lack of commitment to attend school or follow student expectations as set out.

The Director/Principal is responsible for student discipline. A student may require discipline for a number of reasons including safety concerns, behavior or academics. The Director/Principal, will meet with the student(s) who do not follow the rules and remind students of the expectations of each student who attends SEC.

Parents and/or guardians are informed of all student disciplinary attempts. The Director/Principal will set out expectations that the student must meet in order to remain at SEC. A contract will be created, and signed by the student. The parent and/or guardian will be informed about the contents of the contract, and the expectations the student must meet in order to remain at SEC.

If the student fails to meet the expectations, the student will be removed from SEC immediately. Parents will again be informed of this decision.

A student, who is withdrawn, will be permitted to apply for re-entry after 1 year. Applications from these students will be reviewed to see if the student has made changes in the last year with regards to the reason for withdrawal. Further information may be requested of this student.

Student Expulsion

SEC Board is committed to a safe learning and working environment for all students and staff. In order to maintain such an environment, expulsions of students are sometimes necessary. Expulsion of a student is considered a very serious course of action and is in response to student behaviour that is severe, dangerous and poses a risk or threat to the student or to other student(s) and/or staff.

When a student is expelled, it means that he or she is barred from attending SEC immediately. The expulsion is permanent. Re-entry is not permitted.

The Director/Principal in consultation with the Board Chairperson has the right to expel a student.
