

POLICY # G.1.E

## **Cannabis, Alcohol and Illicit Drugs**

Shall further be referred to as **substances**;

Southeast Collegiate must ensure a safe and secure teaching, living and learning environment that supports the intellectual, human, social and career development of all students. In order to maintain positive teaching, living and learning environments, SEC acknowledges its responsibility, in cooperation with students, parents and the community, to take appropriate action regarding consuming **substances** or having **substances** on property. Southeast will therefore:

- Create and maintain a safe and healthy environment by keeping substances out of the environment, whereby searches are made if necessary,
- Assist students adversely affected by their own or another's person's substance
  use to make healthy lifestyle choices and provide them with access to counselling
  and/or rehabilitative programming, where appropriate,
- Provide students with information that increases awareness of risks and impacts on relationships, as well as identifies and promotes the understanding of **substance** use and appropriate intervention and acknowledges the legal implications, such as underage drinking or drug use,
- Establish a consistent approach across Southeast Collegiate by providing staff with information and procedures concerning the preventative, early intervention, disciplinary and rehabilitative aspects of **substance** use as they relate to users, nonusers and affected others, and
- Cooperate with appropriate law enforcement agencies in prevention and in the management of **substance**-related incidents.
- The accompanying procedures outline the process that will be taken by Southeast to
  prevent and respond to substances consumed by students on or off property, and
  those substances that are on property.
