

POLICY # G.1.J.

Administration of Medications to Students

SEC acknowledges that some students may require prescribed medication while in attendance at SEC. SEC also realizes that there are students who require prescribed medication and who, because of age, maturity level, or physical or cognitive ability, are unable to manage their own medication. All prescribed or otherwise As a result, with safety for all students on campus, all medications will be kept at gender specific offices, and dispensed at the lodge by a trained Youth Care Leader.

Not only will all prescribed medications be required to be kept and dispensed, but all non-prescribed medication will be kept under this policy as well for safety reasons.

Parent/Guardians must complete the required waivers in order for SEC employees to administer and dispense medications to students. Without waivers, the student will not be given medication, and should the student be prescribed medication by a Doctor, the student may have to return home, and be withdrawn from SEC for safety reasons.

Further too, the Board requires that the standard be followed for the administration of medication by SEC staff.
