



Managing Health Care Requests

SEC recognizes that students may require a variety of health care needs while away from parents/guardians. These may include, Doctors, Dentists, or specialists in many fields. As a service to parents/guardians, we can help to manage these requests.

We have a local dentist within walking distance who has been working with us for over 10 years.

We also have an onsite clinic which is under the WRHA authority that runs every Wednesday night, that is partnered with Northern Connections Health, that can accommodate students medical needs. If there is a need outside these hours we can take them to this clinic or a nearby hospital to ensure there medical needs are addressed.

Medical needs can become serious in nature, and may require for a parent/guardian to come to Winnipeg to be with their student. We are unable to provide supervisory care in hospital over a 24 hour period. You will be asked to come in to look after medical needs for your student. Funding is not available from Southeast for this.

The Board authorizes SEC staff to manage health care of only those students' parents/guardians who complete the Waiver G.1.K EX1 for release of medical information , as well as Waivers G.1.K EX 2.

This consent form **does not** authorize us to consent to treatment for serious injuries on your students behalf. We cannot consent to treatment for health, dental or other injuries, seizures or illnesses that require further medical treatment at a hospital or a doctor's office. You will be notified of all emergencies.

The Board requires that the following procedure for Managing Health Care Requests be followed.
